

2013 "B" Divisional Volunteer Form and Notes

Hello to all the "B" division teams. As you know, Middletown will be hosting the "B" Divisional Championship Meet on Saturday, July 20th, at the Middletown Swim Club, 1100 N. Union Street in Middletown, directly across from the Middletown High School. This a 25 meter pool. Warm-up times will be posted by Thursday, July 18th, based on the amount of swimmers you are bringing to this meet to compete.

This meet is optional and is the first in a series of Championship Meets. The "A" and "C" divisions will also have their divisional meets at the same time at other locations. Even though we are only swimming the teams in our division, we are actually competing against all the teams in the other two divisions at this event. The results from all three divisions are compiled together. The top 16 swimmers from each individual event and the top 8 relay teams from each age group, as well as two alternates, will go onto the All-Stars Meet the following day (July 21st), in Annville. If your swimmer has qualified for All-Stars, your team's coach(es) will call later Saturday evening. If your swimmer does well at All -Stars, he/she may qualify for the Mid-Caps meet the next weekend on July 27th, at the Hershey Aquatic Club, (this meet puts the top 8 swimmers in each age group & event from the East Shore, Mid-Penn league up against the top 8 swimmers from the West Shore, Capital Area league). **Swimmers accepting an invitation to compete at the All-Stars on Sunday, July 21st.....HE/SHE MUST BE AVAILABLE TO SWIM AT MIDCAPS ON SATURDAY, JULY 27TH, IF HE/SHE QUALIFIES.**

Your swimmer may request a total of three events, any combination.

The fee is **\$8.00 per swimmer** (not per event.....i.e. 1 swimmer=\$8.00, 2 swimmers/children swimming=\$16.00. etc.)

All entries must be received at mshipkowski658@comcast.net, by 7:00pm, Sunday, July 14th. Coaches are fully responsible for the accuracy of their team's entries. Please double check your entries!! Make sure to include relay alternates (1 or 2) to your relay entries if needed! ALL ENTRIES WILL BE RETURNED TO EACH TEAM BY MONDAY, AND SHOULD BE REVIEWED AND RETURNED WITH ANY CORRECTIONS

BY TUESDAY AT 7:00PM. NO CHANGES WILL BE MADE TO THE MEET AFTER THIS TIME, only to make scratches to those events.

The Scratch Meeting will start at 8:00AM. This meeting is to scratch any of your swimmers from the race(s) they have entered. **THIS IS NOT A CHANCE TO CHANGE SWIMMER'S EVENTS OR MAKE CHANGES TO YOUR ENTRIES. NO DECK SEEDING WILL BE ACCEPTED!!**
