Dear Coaches and Reps:

The Annville-Cleona Otters Swim Team is looking forward to hosting you and your swimmers for the 2025 MPSL All-Star Meet on July 20. The meet will feature those swimmers from all three divisions of the Mid-Penn Swim League who have the 16 fastest times in individual events and the eight fastest times in relay events from the combined results of the three respective Divisional Championship Meets held on Saturday, July 19.

The meet will include two (2) heats for individual events and one (1) heat of each relay event. For volunteer purposes only, the meet will be divided into two sessions:

Session 1

Event 1 (Boys 8 & under Medley Relay) - Event 38 (Girls 15-18 Backstroke)

Session 2

Event 39 (Boys 9-10 100 Free) – Event 76 (Girls 15-18 Freestyle Relay)

Mid-Penn Swim League All-Star Championships

July 20, 2025

Site: This meet is hosted by the Annville-Cleona Otters Swim Team, A-C Pool, 1901 E. Maple Street, Annville, PA, 17003. <https://goo.gl/maps/xWd2siwdfKt>

A large parking lot is adjacent to the facility. Overflow parking is available at the UPMC Health facility on Main Street.

The pool, with a bulkhead, is a 25-meter, 8 lane pool. Water depth at the starting end is 5 feet. Three timers will time each lane, using the Dolphin semi-automatic Colorado timing system. The middle time will be the official time.

Eligibility: In each event the top 16 individual times and the top 8 relay team times from the combined results of the three divisional meets held July 19, 2025 will swim at All-Stars. All-Star qualifiers will be seeded from divisional results via Meet Manager. Divisional hosts will be given instructions for this process. Please give the names of any swimmers who will not be participating in the All-Star Meet to the computer person at your Divisional site prior to the start of your divisional meet for transmittal to the All-Star host. All-Star qualifiers will be posted on the Mid-Penn website (www.swimmpsl.org) and the Otter website (www.swimotters.org) as soon as possible on Saturday. A swimmer must be available to swim Mid-Caps if they swim in the All-Star meet. Any team who scratches a swimmer for Mid-Caps without prior written permission from the league or a doctor's excuse may be fined by the league.

Order of Events: Same as dual meets

Starting Times: Meet starts at 9:25 AM

Scratch Meeting at 8:15 AM

Officials/Timers Meeting at 8:40 AM

Mid-Cap Coaches Meeting will be held immediately following the conclusion of the meet

Warmup Times:

Warmups begin at 7:00 a.m. Exact time/lane assignments will be based on the number of swimmers who qualify for the meet from each team. Teams are assigned to the following sessions for circle swimming only based on the number of entries from each team so that everyone has the maximum space available for their swimmers. Teams will get their warm up assignments when the psych sheets are posted.

Volunteers: We need everyone's help to run an efficient meet. We are asking each team to provide 6 timers, 1 ribbon table staffer and officials. We ask teams to provide on-deck officials who have MPSL certification. The meet referees will be responsible for assigning officials based on certifications. We would prefer certifications of PIAA or US swimming or YMCA for this event. On deck officials should wear white shirts and navy bottoms and have certification badges visible. We will offer FREE ADMISSION FOR ALL VOLUNTEERS. By Monday, July 14, please provide names of volunteers on the google doc. If parents are unwilling to commit, please list possible volunteers with a "conditional" notation on the form. All volunteers will check in at the volunteer table at the front entrance of the pool. Even if your team cannot provide specific names at this time, you will be responsible for filling your team slots on meet day. You may feel free to contact other teams who may have extra volunteers available to help fill your slots. Please submit the names of your volunteers via google docs. Admission: \$5 admission fee (12 and over) Swimmers, coaches and working volunteers are free. Gates and parking lots open at 6:30 a.m. WE WILL NOT HAVE A PAPER PROGRAM THIS YEAR. A QR CODE WILL BE AVAILABLE AT THE GATE TO DOWNLOAD A DIGITAL PROGRAM. WE WILL ALSO HAVE THE PROGRAM LINK AVAILABLE ON OUR WEBSITE AFTER THE HEAT SHEETS ARE FINALIZED.

Team Fees: Event fees are \$5.00 per individual event and \$20.00 per relay. Teams will be billed by MPSL at the conclusion of the season.

Hospitality: We will provide a hospitality tent for officials and coaches. We will also provide free heat sheets for three coaches from each team. We will supply on-deck timers, officials and other volunteers with beverages.

Photography: ALL PHOTOGRAPHS OR VIDEOS TAKEN DURING ANY SWIM MEET MUST BE TAKEN **ON THE SIDE OF THE POOL BETWEEN THE BACKSTROKE FLAGS**. NO PHOTOGRAPHS OR VIDEOS MAY BE TAKEN FROM THE START (BLOCKS) OR TURN END OF THE POOL. NO EXCEPTIONS. THIS INCLUDES THE USE OF CELL PHONES.

Restrooms: Pool restrooms are available for swimmer use only. Portable restrooms will be available for spectators. We will have a handicap accessible portable restroom available for those that may need one.

Swim Shop: **T&T Swimming** will be on site to provide a selection of swimming apparel and training equipment for sale.

Submission of Meet Results from Divisional Hosts to All-Star Host (A-C)

TO: Division A, B, and C Meet Directors and Computer Operators

Below is the procedure each division should follow to relay Divisional meet results to ACL in preparation of the All- Star Championship meet the next day.

- 1) Immediately send ACL meet day contact info via email. Include a contact person and a phone number where that person can be reached on Saturday during and after the Divisional meets. (This will most likely be a cell phone number.)
- 2) Coaches must submit their known All-Star meet scratches in an email WITH their divisional entries. If you receive divisional meet entries from a team without a list of known All-Star meet scratches, email the submitting coach back and ask him or her for known All-Star meet scratches. Immediately place these scratches into

you can access and edit this document if necessary up to Saturday July 19.

ALL SCRATCHES MUST BE SUBMITTED BY THE CONCLUSION OF YOUR DIVISIONAL MEET.

The divisional meet referee should also hold a scratch meeting following the meet to determine if any other swimmers will scratch prior to submission of the results. These may also be placed in the google doc. If you have questions on how to fill in the google doc please

- 3) At the conclusion of the meet on Saturday, July 19, 2025, send ACL a backup of the meet via email. Send the backup as an attachment. Scratches should be on the google doc.

DO NOT MAKE THE SCRATCHES IN YOUR BACK UP!

THEY WILL BE SCRATCHED OUT BY ACL AFTER THE RESULTS ARE MERGED.

Text the cell phone listed below after your email has been sent. That way, we will know immediately if we have a problem.

After ACL receives all three backups, we will post All-Star seeding/psych sheets on the Otters and Mid-Penn websites. Sixteen (16) swimmers and two alternates will be listed, except for relay events, which will list eight (8) teams and two alternate teams.

Please be prompt in emailing this information. If all progresses as planned, everything should be on the Otters (www.swimotters.org) and Mid-Penn websites around 6 p.m. on Saturday, July 19.
