### ***Eligibility***

In order to swim at the Divisional Meet, Swimmers must have participated in at least 2 meets this summer (2 Dual Meets or 1 Dual/1 Invitational). Entry times must be from the MPSL dual or invitational meets since June 1, 2024. Swimmers are limited to 3 events, including relays.

### ***Entries and Results***

All entries for the meet must be submitted electronically through Meet Manager by **Sunday, July 13, at 5:00 p.m.** Email the entries to Richard Laughlin [r laughlin826@gmail.com](mailto:r laughlin826@gmail.com) . Each team will receive a confirmation email to verify their entries by **Monday, July 14th at 9:00 p.m.** Each team is responsible for verification of their entries.

**Any corrections must be brought to the host team's attention no later than Tuesday, July 15th at 9:00 p.m.**

Swimmers are limited to three (3) events. Entries must be made using meter times and standard event numbers established by the league and shall follow all other rules for divisional entries established by the league.

The coaches results file will be available as soon as possible following the end of the meet via USB drive. The meet will be on MeetMobile App. and results will be posted on the MPSL website.

### ***Entry Fees***

Individual events are \$5 per event entry. Relay Events are \$20, per entry. Event fee checks should be made payable to Dauphin Swim Team and sent to PO Box 9 Dauphin PA 17018. Fee totals are established by final entries submitted Tuesday, July 15th Refunds will not be given for scratches. *There will also be a \$5.00 Athlete Surcharge to help subsidize MPSL yearly costs. Teams will be invoiced by the MPSL after the competition for this fee.*

### ***Officials and Volunteers***

Volunteers serving as judges or referees should wear white and display their certified official patches. Dolphin Timing System is used so there will be 3 timers/lane and no finish judges and manual stopwatches will also be on hand. All volunteers should be in their assigned area at least five minutes prior to their start times. Volunteers will enter for free and given a volunteer bracelet at the spectator/volunteer entrance.

We need the following volunteers from each visiting team (Time to sign up links will be sent to each team and must be filled by July 17th.)

- 4 Officials
- 6 timers for each half (12 total spots)
- 1 Ribbon person (one team will have a HyTek assistant instead of ribbons)

### ***Awards***

Ribbons will be given out for 1<sup>st</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> place in both individual and first 6 places for relay events.

### ***Photography***

Per MPSL Rules, ***all photographs and videos taken during the event must be from the side of the pool, between the backstroke flags.*** No Photographs or videos may be taken from behind the starting blocks or at the turn end of the pool. No exceptions. This includes the use of cell phones.

### ***Facilities and Amenities***

The meet will be held at the Dauphin Swim Club, Dauphin, PA. Pool rules and regulations are posted in the locker rooms. All guests, volunteers, and swimmers agree to abide by those rules upon entry onto the Dauphin Swim Club property. Anyone who does not abide by those rules will be asked to leave the property. Parents and Coaches are responsible for the actions of minor children in their care. Baby pool is closed during the meet.

### ***Designated Areas***

Areas surrounding the pool and directly behind the starting blocks are designated for meet officials, meet stagers and timers only. **All coaches, spectators and un-staged swimmers must remain clear of these areas. We must be able to have as much quiet as possible behind the block area and not interfere with timers or swimmers approaching the blocks (3 timers in each lane makes this area more congested).** These designated areas will be clearly marked off with caution tape.

Locker room/Bathroom is for swimmers only. Spectators are to use the Port-a-Johns located along the fence behind the blocks.

### ***Concessions***

A full concession stand will be provided inside the pool property. Auntie Annes, Kona Ice and ToEspresso Coffee truck will also be on premise for additional concession options. Cash preferred but we also accept credit cards.

### ***Admission to the Meet for Guests, Swimmers, and Volunteers***

Guest admission is \$5.00 per person (12 and under are free). Swimmers, Coaches and Volunteers enter for free, however Coaches and Volunteers must check in at the Volunteer Table located at the gate. **When looking at the pool from Claster Blvd Spectator and Volunteer Entrance is to the right of the pool (by the baseball field). Concessions and food trucks are located at the normal pool entrance by the handicapped parking spaces – We prefer everyone enter the other entrance noted above to avoid congestion in the concession area. Handicapped attendees are an exception and we will accommodate as needed.**

Parking attendants will be directing parking around the pool. There are some Handicapped spaces on the side of the building by the swimmer entrance (only vehicles with handicapped placards will be able to park in those spaces (per pool policy).
