

Mid-Penn Swim League All-Star Championships July 21, 2002

Site: Hosted by Hershey Aquatic Club at the Hershey Recreation Center, 605 Cocoa Avenue, Hershey, PA 17033. A large parking lot is adjacent to the facility. The pool is a 25 yard, 6-lane pool with Colorado Timing System and 6-lane scoreboard display. Water depth at the starting end is 11 feet. Touch pads will be used at both ends.

Eligibility: In each event, the top 12 individual times and the top 6 relay teams from the combined results of the three divisional meets held July 20, 2002, will swim at All-Stars. Procedure to seed qualifiers from the Divisional Meets to All-Stars will be done by modem. Divisional hosts will be given instructions for this process. **Please give the names of any swimmers who will not be participating in the All-Star Meet to the computer person at your Divisional site.** All-Star qualifiers will be posted on the Mid-Penn web site www.swimmpsl.com.
